

PRINCETON, NJ: Twelve young people from seven municipalities were confirmed as members of Princeton United Methodist Church on June 5. In the confirmation service, they publicly affirmed and accepted the grace of God and pledged to be disciples of God.

“Our aim is to get the students to know what they believe and why they believe it. We encourage our students to study the Scripture for themselves and to examine how our historic traditions, along with their own experience and understanding, shape their personal faith,” says Susan Victor, who co-taught the class with Cathie Capp, an intern from Princeton Theological Seminary. “It is always an honor to be a part of a person's faith journey.”

“We welcome them as disciples of Christ and pray that as they continue the journey of growing in faith they will experience this congregation as place that encourages and nurtures them,” says Rev. Jana Purkis-Brash, senior pastor.

Victor, a provisional deacon in the United Methodist Church, is a counselor and chaplain at Womanspace Inc. Capp will be a third year student at the seminary.

Located at the corner of Nassau and Vandeventer in Princeton, PUMC is a diverse congregation whose members come from many surrounding communities, backgrounds, and faith histories.
